

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

Students are not permitted to use cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, or CD players during instructional time. "Use" is defined as having the device on, out in class, having the device go off in class including vibrating, use of text messaging, retrieval of a message, checking or entering phone numbers, changing CDs, and reaching for the device in a backpack or purse. Electronic devices may only be use before/after school, break, and lunch. All devices must be turned off and out of sight during class time. Use of an electronic device during instructional time is treated as a classroom disturbance. If a student uses an electronic device during class, the following consequences will be enforced:

1st Offense – Item will be confiscated from student, turned over to Administration, item returned to parent, and warning of Saturday School on next offense.

2nd Offense – Item will be confiscated from student, turned over to Administration, item returned to parent, Saturday School will be assigned, and warning of suspension on next offense.

3rd Offense – Item will be confiscated from student, turned over to Administration, item returned to parent, and student will be suspended from school for defiance of school authority.

4th Offense – Item will be confiscated from student, turned over to Administration, item will remain in office for remainder of school year, and student will be suspended from school for defiance of school authority.

Newport Harbor High School is not responsible for any lost or stolen item brought on campus by the student. If the student elects to bring an item to campus, he/she is responsible for the supervision of his/her personal property.
